Title: Sounds that Grow Cookie Policy

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Sounds that Grow's website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps to provide you with a good experience when you browse the website and also allows Sounds that Grow to improve its site.

Website Hosting and Cookies

Our website is hosted on **Wix.com**, and as part of providing website services, Wix may set technical cookies to support site functionality, collect analytical data, and improve performance. Wix acts as a data processor, and all data handled by Wix is managed in compliance with applicable data protection laws.

A cookie is a small text file which is placed onto your computer (or other electronic device) when you access the website.

Sounds that Grow uses cookies on this website to:

- Recognise you whenever you visit this website (this speeds up your access to the website as you do not have to log in each time)
- Obtain information about your preferences, online movements, and use of the internet
- Carry out research and statistical analysis to help improve content, products, and services, and to help better understand Sounds that Grow's visitor requirements and interests
- Target marketing and advertising campaigns more effectively by providing interest-based advertisements that are personalised to your interests
- Make your online experience more efficient and enjoyable

The information Sounds that Grow obtains from the use of cookies will not usually contain your personal data. Although it may obtain information about your computer or other electronic device such as your IP address, your browser, and/or other internet log information, this will not usually identify you personally. In certain circumstances, Sounds that Grow may collect personal information about you—but only where you voluntarily provide it (e.g., by completing an online form).

Types of Cookies Used

Sounds that Grow uses the following types of cookies:

- **Strictly Necessary Cookies:** These are cookies that are required for the operation of the website.
- **Analytical or Performance Cookies:** These recognise and count the number of visitors to the website and see how visitors move around the website when they are using it. This helps to improve the way the website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
- **Functionality Cookies:** These are used to recognise you when you return to Sounds that Grow's website. This enables personalised content and preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).
- **Targeting Cookies:** These cookies record your visit to Sounds that Grow's website, the pages you have visited, and the links you have followed. This information will be used to make the website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests.

Apart from 'strictly necessary cookies', your consent is needed in order to use cookies on this website.

First and Third Party Cookies

- **First-party cookies:** Cookies set by Sounds that Grow's website.
 - **Third-party cookies:** Cookies on Sounds that Grow's website that are set by another website, such as where there are adverts or Facebook pixels showing relevant content from Sounds that Grow when you are on Facebook.
